The classification of an alumnus is established by the *first degree* earned from this Seminary. The classification has no special significance other than to provide a convenient method for filing alumni records and to group together alumni who have done similar work.

The first regular undergraduate degree was awarded in 1921.

Every student who matriculates at Princeton Theological Seminary eventually becomes an alumnus or alumna whether or not he or she receives a degree. Everyone is made a member of some class whether or not the person was graduated or was in a regular degree program. The "class-year" relates either to the date when the degree was received or would have been received or to the final year of enrollment for courses as a special student. Doctoral students are temporarily classified by the year when residency was completed, until they actually receive the degree.

In the period 1897-1920 the Seminary awarded a "B.D." degree to certain students for high scholarship or for additional graduate work. This roughly corresponded to the Th.M., so that those who received the "B.D." in this era as their *only* degree are given the symbol "M."

Persons receiving more than one degree from Princeton Theological Seminary will have the corresponding symbols in the square brackets after the name at the head of each individual biographical sketch. Examples: [MD] or [BMD] or [BP].

## ABBREVIATIONS

Abbreviations in the 1977 edition of the Biographical Catalogue have been reduced from a list of more than eighteen pages in the 1955 edition. To achieve this reduction the names of schools, colleges, and universities are written in full in the text of each biography.
